## Program Details

### Fees:\*

\$4 per visitor; maximum of 40 participants for each 1.5 hour program.

### Length and Setting:

Each program is approximately 1.5 hours long. All programs include a nature hike (in case of inclement weather, indoor activities will replace the nature hike).

### When:

Monday thru Friday between 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.

### More Information:

- ✓ All programs include hands-on, multidisciplinary activities that encourage classroom connections.
- ✓ Work with Center Staff to tailor programs to your needs and the ability level of your students.
- ✓ Pre-registration and advance payment required for all programs.
- ✓ Cancellations must be made in writing 10 business days prior to your visit date or you will be billed for 50% of your program fee.
- ✓ At least 1 adult chaperone per 10 students is required. Kindergarten classes must have 1 adult chaperone per 6 students.
- ✓ To best enjoy your trip please remember to dress for the weather and wet conditions at the Center.
- ✓ You may bring a trail side snack for the scouts.
